Comments: Numbers were well down compared to last week in a mixed quality yarding. Good bullocks & cows were well supplied, however the market was slightly easier with most sales back by around 10c/kg. Although it was back, there were still some excellent results. The bulk of the young cattle were of lesser quality which reflected a cheaper market, again, the better quality stock saw pleasing results.
