Comments: There was an increase of around 200 this week with 430 head yarded. A good run of both bullocks and cows came forward, with bullocks fully firm and cows selling up to 15c/kg dearer to top at 326.2c/kg. Heavy bulls were also well supplied, the top of 320c/kg was achieved with most sales over 300c/kg. Young cattle were better in quality this week, selling fully firm in a very strong market.
