Comments: Once again large numbers rolled forward with a big percentage being export cattle, the majority of those cows. The market couldn't hold last weeks prices with numbers again hitting the market in most other selling centres. Bullocks sold 5-8c/kg cheaper while heavy cows were back by 10c/kg. Light cows saw limited competition selling 20c/kg cheaper. Prime vealers were hardest hit with most sales struggling to reach 200c/kg. Quality Angus weaner steers sold slightly dearer, while once again light or off quality cattle were very hard to shift.
