Comments: Numbers fell by 200 this week in an overall plainer quality yarding. Bullocks were too few to quote, while cows and vealers sold fully firm. Feeder steers sold 20c/kg stronger, topping at 296c/kg with most sales 280-290c/kg. Yearlings over 300kg sold dearer by 10c/kg topping at 232.2c/kg. Restockers sold slightly cheaper mainly due to the lesser quality yarding.
