Comments: Numbers were up slightly this week, again, some good lines of export cattle were yarded. One major processor was absent which reflected in a cheaper market by 10c/kg for both bullocks and cows. The quality of the young cattle was patchy, however, the market was fully firm. Feeder steers were in short supply but high demand, topping at 440c/kg.
