Comments: There was a big jump in numbers this week as many producers decided to offload before the Christmas break. This is the case in most other selling centres which has created an over supply and put a downward trend on in the market. In Grafton prices for most categories fell 10-20c/kg, the only exception being quality restocker steers which sold fully firm. Plain or light cattle were most effected and sold accordingly.
