Comments: A mostly plain quality yarding was on offer this week, only 279 in total. There were too few bullocks to quote, however cows sold cheaper by 30-35c/kg, mainly due to a couple of processors deciding to sit on the bench this week, as kill space starts to fill before Christmas. Young cattle were met by strong competition, whilst the plain quality cattle were quite cheaper.
