Comments: Numbers eased this week in a better quality yarding. Bullocks were in short supply however, there was a good yarding of cows which sold firm to slightly dearer. Vealers under 300kg sold to 216.2c/kg, whilst those over sold to 224.2c/kg which was better by 10c/kg. Quality Angus weaner steers under 250c/kg met with good local competition reaching a top of 260.2c/kg. Light heifers and off quality cattle were similar to recent weeks becoming harder to shift as the dry continues.
