Comments: Following last weeks big sell off and lower prices, numbers fell dramatically in a fair quality yarding. Bullocks topped at 221c/kg while cows saw yet another price correction, down a further 30c/kg to sell to a top of 156.2c/kg. Prime butchers yearlings and vealers were very scare which made them hard to quote while the few restockers sold similar to the weaner sale to local buyers prepared to take a punt of the chance of rain.
