Comments: There was a big lift in numbers this week as the pre-Easter sell off takes place across most selling centres. The big numbers put pressure on the supply chain, which saw most categories sell to a cheaper trend, the only exception being bullocks, feeder steers and export heifers. An excellent run of heavy cows came forward and sold 5-8c/kg cheaper, while boner cows fell 10-15c/kg cheaper. Quality restocker steers were slightly cheaper, while vealers to restockers were harder hit, falling up to 25c/kg.
