Comments: The combined Fat & Store Sale held this week saw an increased yarding of cattle both prime and store condition. Bullocks were in short supply but sold firm to dearer, export heifers followed the same trend. Good heavy cows also sold slightly dearer however, light weight cows were back 10-20c/kg. The young cattle saw a mixed market with quality steers selling well up to 260c/kg. It was a different story for light cattle and vealers, with most sales back 20-30c/kg and more for lesser quality types.
