Comments: There was an influx of numbers this week following last weeks price rise. All the usual buyers were operating in a firm to dearer market. Bullocks didn't quite meet last weeks high, however, they still sold very well. Cows lifted by 5-8c/kg. Vealers saw the best price rise with an isolated sale reaching 266.2c/kg, with most sales making between 240-250c/kg.
